Our Caring Continues . . . Handling Your Pet's Body After Death

We treat your pet's body with respect and dignity after he or she has passed away.

We encourage you to comply with all state, provincial, and local laws. These are the options we can provide you at this difficult time:

☐ You may have your pet's remains returned to you for personal disposition, if local laws allow you to do so. A biodegradable coffin or bag may be provided for you, should you choose to use one.
Estimated cost:
☐ Your pet may be buried at a communal burial site by our hospital or a well-respected service used by our hospital.
Estimated cost:
☐ Your pet may be cremated in a communal setting by our hospital or a well-respected service used by our hospital. The ashes will not be returned to you.
Estimated cost:
☐ Your pet may be cremated privately by our hospital or a well-respected service used our hospital. The ashes will be returned to you or the hospital in a simple urn.* A certificate will be provided to you verifying that the ashes you receive are from only your pet.
Estimated cost:
*If you would like a personalized urn or other commemorative memento containing the ashes (jewelry, statue, mixed with plant seeds/soil, and so on), please discuss this with o staff. We may be able to facilitate your request.

After your pet has passed away, with your permission, our hospital staff may gently obtain a lock of fur, paw print, or other physical memory of your pet for you.

To keep your pet's body cool prior to cremation or burial, our hospital may store the carefully labeled body in a freezer designated only for this use.
