Animal-specific factors	Nutrient-sensitive disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Adverse food reactions ● Overweight or obesity ● Organ-specific disease 	Selection of diets formulated to address the specific disease-associated nutrient limitations
Diet-specific factors	Diet-induced disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Nutrient imbalance ● Spoilage ● Contamination ● Adulteration 	Feeding a diet appropriate for the animal
Feeding management	Feeding-related and environmental-related disorders	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Over- or underfeeding ● Excessive use of treats ● Poor husbandry ● Competitive eating ● Lack of appropriate environmental stimulation 	Effective communication with the client
